



RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Wearing a helmet is MANDATORY when riding for anyone under the age of eighteen (18) years. Adults who wish to ride without a helmet must signify on the Release and Waiver of Liability document that they are choosing not to wear a helmet by initialing at #10.
2. Safety is of the utmost importance and the responsibility of everyone. In case of emergency (ie, medical, theft, vandalism in progress): Call 911.
3. Horse owners and guests must have a signed Release and Waiver of Liability document on file before entering the barn or riding areas.
4. Management will control the watering down of the arena prior to use.
5. Pick up manure as quickly as possible in any area outside of your stall.
6. Close gates securely after exiting arenas or paddocks.
7. Visiting dogs must be on a short leash and under the control of the dog's owner at all times. No dogs are allowed in the arenas, paddocks, or stalls.
8. Playing or climbing on trees, shavings bin, hay, or equipment is prohibited.
9. Children under the age of twelve (12) years old must be under adult supervision.
10. Youth age eighteen (18) years old and under must be enrolled in a program, with an instructor or trainer, or under management supervision when spending multiple hours at Double Mountain Horse Ranch, LLC.
11. Horses are to be ridden, at the walk only, when riding outside of the arenas or designated riding areas.
12. Riding in the barn is prohibited.
13. Speed limit on all grounds is 5 miles per hour (mph) or slower.
14. Any equipment brought into an arena must be removed after use.
15. Tie horses in designated areas only.
16. Wash horses in designated areas only. Keep nozzles on hoses and clean up after use. Be water-wise and limit your time washing your horse and/or equipment.
17. If you notice any damage to arena and/or facility, please notify management immediately.
18. Shoeing, trimming and resets area must be cleaned of all manure, hoof clippings, nails, shoes, etc. when finished.
